

MA in Aging Studies to Master of Health Administration

Program Requirements

Graduates earning the MA in aging studies with a concentration in healthcare leadership (<http://catalog.wichita.edu/graduate/health-professions/health-sciences/public-health-sciences/ma-in-aging-studies-age/>) can apply the 12 concentration credit hours to the Master of Health Administration (MHA) (<http://catalog.wichita.edu/graduate/health-professions/health-sciences/public-health-sciences/master-health-administration/>). The graduate school regulation stating a maximum of 6-credit hours of work earned from one WSU masters may be applied to a second WSU masters is nullified. The dual curriculum allows students to pursue two WSU graduate degrees within a reasonable time frame and with reduced financial burden. The aging studies program must be completed before any course can be applied to the MHA.
