

BBA - Accounting

Program Requirements

A minimum total of 120 credit hours is required for the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) in accounting. In addition to meeting the requirements of the WSU General Education Program (<http://catalog.wichita.edu/undergraduate/academic-information/general-education-program/>) and the requirements for all BBA programs (<http://catalog.wichita.edu/undergraduate/w-frank-barton-business/bachelor-of-business-administration/>) set by the W. Frank Barton School of Business, candidates for the BBA in accounting must satisfy the following requirements of the curricular major:

All majors must contain at least 12 unduplicated credit hours. All minors must contain at least 3 unduplicated credit hours.

Applied Learning

Students in the BBA in accounting program are required to complete an applied learning or research experience to graduate from this program.

The requirement can be met by taking ACCT 610 Advanced Financial Accounting.

As part of this course, students are required to complete a semester-long nonprofit project using Premium Access Tools, Data, Analyses and Tax Returns from Guidestar.org. This Premium Access, provided free to students, normally costs \$1,500 annually per person.
