

# BBA - Economics

## Program Requirements

A minimum total of 120 credit hours is required for the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) in economics. In addition to meeting the requirements of the WSU General Education Program (<http://catalog.wichita.edu/undergraduate/academic-information/general-education-program/>) and the requirements for all BBA programs (<http://catalog.wichita.edu/undergraduate/w-frank-barton-business/bachelor-of-business-administration/>) set by the W. Frank Barton School of Business, candidates for the BBA in economics must satisfy the following requirements of the curricular major:

All majors must contain at least 12 unduplicated credit hours. All minors must contain at least 3 unduplicated credit hours.
